- 1. The candidates should produce evidence of all certificates and mark sheets on or before 5 pm at the time of counseling (22.08.23).
- 2. The candidates seeking admission under the quota for differently abled candidates should produce the medical certificate duly issued by the district medical board.
- 3. The candidates seeking admission under Government school quota (7.5%) should produce, at the time of reporting for admission, the original certificate to the effect that they have studied in Government Schools continuously from 6th Std. to 12thStd, duly signed by (i) the Head master of the school concerned, and (ii) the DEO or CEO concerned.
- The candidates who do not report for counseling at the stipulated date and time will lose the seat and cannot claim the seat afterwards.
- The candidates called for counseling are not assured of admission as the admission process will be strictly based on merit amongst the candidates reporting for counseling.
- 6. The candidates should pay the counselling fee at the time of counselling as mentioned below.
