## Stakeholder's Feedback and Student Satisfaction Survey-2018-19: An Analysis

Inferences of the feedback obtained during 2018-19 are,

- 1. Academic programmes lacking Industrial visits, internships/in-plant trainings need to be restructured during the revision of syllabi.
- 2. More number of value-added courses shall be introduced to enhance skill, employability and professional competency.
- 3. Facilitate extracurricular activities in the campus regularly and provide better hostel amenities and ambience.
- 4. The feed-back questioner needs to be improved with open-ended questions to address the gray areas.

## Action taken

- 1. In many academic programmes, experiential learning/ internship/project are introduced during the syllabus revision in the year 2019-20.
- 2. As suggested more value-added courses are introduced. In First level 30 courses and in advanced level 15 courses are offered. To make it convenient for the students to choose the course, the details are made available in student portal.
- 3. Steps have been taken to organise more number of extracurricular activities at faculty level to enhance the participation.
- 4. Meticulous steps are taken to improve hostel amenities.
- 5. The questionnaires are modified and added with open-ended question.
