

## Minutes of the Meeting of the IQAC convened at 11.00 a.m. on 11th April 2019 at Conference Hall, Golden Jubilee Building.

A Meeting of the IQAC was convened at 11.00 a.m. on 11th April 2019 at Conference Hall, Golden Jubilee Building. It was chaired by the Vice-Chancellor. The members of IQAC and special invitees among Annamalai University Faculty were present. The following items were taken up for discussion.

The Vice-Chancellor noted the importance of upgrading the NAAC score from A to A++

The IQAC initiatives taken during the period 1 Feb 2019 to 10 Apr 2019 were reviewed.

The next item discussed was the Re-organization of Departments into Schools.

Dr. Selvam suggested constituting Schools within Faculties since this does not require the approval of the Chancellor but only endorsement by the Syndicate. The Vice-Chancellor replied that the matter will be placed before the Dean's Committee.

The Vice-Chancellor, Dr Selvam and Dr Sethuraman emphasized the importance of incorporating appropriate POs, PSOs and COs for all programmes and mapping them. Dr Sethuraman appreciated the POs for the Ph.D Programme.

The external members Dr Selvam, Dr Sethuraman and Dr Elango observed that, in the spirit of CBCS the Inter-Departmental electives should be available across faculties, including the Music college. No other university in the state has such a wide range of Departments under one roof and students should be enabled to make the most of this disciplinary diversity.

Dr Selvam and Dr Sethuraman suggested that every Department should offer a VAC. A VAC should comprise 60% theory component and 40% practical component and should be offered outside regular class hours

The external members recommended a revised format for Academic Audit and revised forms for student evaluation of teachers.

Dr. Sethuraman observed that students should be administered a diagnostic test at least a couple of weeks after the commencement of a semester. Remedial classes should be arranged for the slow learners and efforts should be taken to ensure that over the semester the gap between them and others is bridged.

Dr. Sethuraman stated that the important textbooks should be shifted from the Department Libraries to the Central Library so that they are more accessible to the students. Dr.Selvam urged reviving the reading rooms which benefited scores of students of Annamalai University in the past, including himself. Dr.Elango observed that our book collection, both of the contemporary books and rare books is probably the best among the universities in the state and strengthening the central library by transferring the important books from the Department Libraries will immensely benefit the academic community. The Vice-Chancellor replied that already steps are being taken to do this at the earliest.

Seminars, workshops and conferences are organized by the various Departments of Study throughout the year. The external members underlined the importance of all these activities being conducted through the aegis of the IOAC.

The external members appreciated the policy of the university to actively involve students in various academic and administrative bodies.

Dr. Sethuraman suggested that students can be allowed to demand revaluation if there is only a single examiner but not if two examiners evaluate answer scripts. However all the members present emphasized the right of students to be provided, on demand, with a Photostat copy of answer scripts along with the mark sheets, irrespective of the number of examiners evaluating the scripts. This promotes transparency in the examination process.

The external members appreciated the initiative to adhere to Bloom's taxonomy in designing examination question papers.

Dr Selvam and Dr Sethuraman emphasized the need to improve the university website.

The other items discussed were: Geo-tagged photographs of infrastructural facilities; Cloud-based system being developed for data collection; and arranging a competition among students to depict the biodiversity in the campus.

The meeting concluded with the external members observing that Annamalai University has a legacy good practice cultivated over the decades. These should be identified and strengthened.
