## Foreword

### **Greetings**

As you are well aware, accreditation/reaccreditation of higher educational institutions by National Assessment and Accreditation Council is of paramount importance in many ways. The NAAC accreditation, besides being a quality indicator, determines other factors like student strength and sanction of grants.

From 2017 onwards, a drastic change has been effected in the data submission process for NAAC accreditation. With an objective to ensure more transparency and accountability, the revised process involves a shift from **qualitative peer judgement** to **data based quantitative indicator evaluation**. It requires that a major amount of data to be submitted should be quantitative so as to be evaluated with the help of ICT. The process has also introduced the phenomenon of **System Generated Scores (SGS)** and **online evaluation** of data (about 70%) along with peer judgement (about 30%).

A functional Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and timely submission of Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQARs) are the Minimum Institutional Requirements (MIR) to volunteer for reaccreditation in the subsequent cycles. The data in Self Study Report (SSR) have to conform to those already provided in the AQARs. Hence, it is the responsibility of the every stakeholder/academic department/ administrative section to keep the data always ready in the required format so that the compilation of AQAR/SSR will be easy and timely submission.

Some of the salient points to be noted are:

- **Data (1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> June) for the preparation of AQAR to be submitted on or before 31<sup>st</sup> July every year**
- **All data should be supported by valid and concrete evidences**
- **All photographs submitted as evidences should be geo-tagged**
- **Feedback submission by students, teachers, alumni, and employers need to be encouraged at the end of every semester to achieve compliance from at least 90% of the total strength**

I appreciate the IQAC, Annamalai University for bringing out this comprehensive user friendly manual that, I hope, will help the individuals, departments and sections to familiarize themselves with the revised process of accreditation and facilitate them in compiling the data in the appropriate formats with ease.

I appeal to Deans, Heads, Faculty, Section Heads, Administrative Staff and others concerned to make use of the manual, follow the guidelines in it and help the University to achieve greater heights.
