Policy of prohibiting sexual harassment

One of the core objectives of Annamalai University (hereinafter referred to as "University") is to ensure gender equality and gender justice through the University interventions and practices. In keeping with this principle, it is important to ensure a climate free from discrimination and harassment, with a particular focus on prevention of sexual harassment. Sexual harassment of individuals occurring in the place of work or study or in other settings in which they may find themselves in connection with their association with the University is unlawful and will not be tolerated by the University. Further, any retaliation against an individual who has complained about sexual harassment complaint is similarly unacceptable. To achieve this goal, conduct that is described as "Sexual harassment" in this policy will not be tolerated and a procedure is provided by which inappropriate conduct will be dealt with, if encountered among employees / students.

The University will also take all the appropriate steps necessary to protect individuals from retaliation. Such steps include:

- Action to stop retaliatory behavior
- Providing required security measures

• Counseling help to complainant and accused.

The University takes allegations of sexual harassment seriously, and will respond promptly to complaints of sexual harassment and where it is determined that such inappropriate conduct has occurred, prompt and appropriate corrective action as is necessary, including disciplinary action, will be taken.

While this policy sets forth the goal of the University of promoting a study or workplace that is free of sexual harassment, the policy is not designed or intended to limit the authority of the University to discipline or take remedial action for conduct which the University deems unacceptable, regardless of whether that conduct satisfies the definition of sexual harassment. The committee organizes an awareness drive among the staff and students of the University to impart knowledge on sexual harassment at work place, the legal aspects and rights. The drive also aims at throwing light on sexual hygiene and effects of nutrition on adolescence.

Independent office and infrastructure

The Complaints committee against sexual harassment at workplace (CCSH) have a designated office with a board outside displaying details of the CCSH. An independent designated separate office with full facilities such as office tables and chairs are available for CCSH in the Faculty of Engineering and Technology (FEAT) of Annamalai University for effective functioning of the committee. The office provides a clear physical boundary between the CCSH and the outside world.

Atwo-day short term training programme on "Gender sensitization and harassment prevention at work place" was organized by Complaints committee against sexual harassment at workplace (CCSH-AU) cell from 16-08-2022 and 17-08-2022. Dr. J. Thirumal, member of CCSH-AU welcomed the meeting. The vice-chancellor, Prof. RM Kathiresan delivered the inaugural address. He started his speech from KambaRamayanam lines and explained the achievements of women. Then the complaints committee chairperson Prof. P. Mullai gave a presidential speech highlighting the importance of women. As a special guest, Mrs.Jayashree Mathimaran gave a detailed speech about gender sensitization and discussed about how both sexes should respect one another. She also discussed about gender differences like male and female and how to overcome such approaches. Prof.Angaiyarkanni spoke about the safety of men and women. Then Dr. Hema Chitra said in her speech that men and women are misusing their freedom and how it should be handled. Mrs.KalaiarasiRamadoss, spoke about the causes of sexual harassment that happen to women in workplacesand explained the laws to prevent harassment. Then, Dr. K. Sivakumar, Dr.T. Frank Sunil Justus and Dr. Rameshkumar, Department of Business Administration trained the students in team coordination and management activities. These activities included small games which inculcated the coordination and team leading skills among the students, and then committee member Dr. Thenmozhi gave the vote of thanks.
