Annamalai University

In the early 1920s Rajah Sir S. R. M. Annamalai Chettiar founded Sri Minakshi college, Sri Minakshi Tamil College and Sri Minakshi Sanskrit College at Chidambaram. In 1928, Rajah Sir S. R. M. Annamalai Chettiar agreed with the local Government to handover the above said institution for establishing a University. Thus, on 01.01.1929 Annamalai University was established as per Annamalai University Act 1928 (Tamil Nadu Act 1 of 1929). One of the most significant developments is the enactment of the Annamalai University Act, 2013 (Tamil Nadu Act 20 of 2013), which has come into force from September 25, 2013. Annamalai University is accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC in 2014. "The NIRF-2019" by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) has ranked the University in the band 101 - 150 in the overall category as well as the University Category. In the Pharmacy Category the ranking is 12 th in India. In the Medical Category the ranking is 25 th. "The Times Higher Education World University Ranking - 2019" has ranked Annamalai University in 1000+ for Overall category. In the Subject category Ranking, 2019, the University is ranked in the band of 501-600 for Life Sciences and Pre-clinical, clinical & Health Subjects. 800+ in the Physical Sciences subject. "The QS World University Ranking - 2019" has ranked Annamalai University in the band of 291 - 300 in Asia Ranking, 174 in the BRICS Ranking and 43 in India Ranking. "The CWTS Leiden Ranking 2018", on scientific impact of universities and on universities' involvement in scientific collaboration & scientific performance, has ranked the University at 20th based on the number of publications and 4 th based on the proportion of publications that, compared with other publications in the same field and in the same year, belong to the top 10% most frequently cited. "The MDRA - India Today Ranking" (2018) has ranked

Annamalai University 13 th among the best Government Universities in India. Among the top 197 ranked institutions for Higher Education in India the "SCImago Institutional Ranking (2018)" has ranked Annamalai University as 7 th in Tamil Nadu and 32nd in India. Annamalai University is one of the largest unitary, teaching, and residential Universities in Southern Asia comprising of 10 Faculties and 49 departments of study. This University has played a pivotal role in providing access to higher education to thousands of youth cutting across the social spectrum, especially from economically and socially disadvantaged classes. In this respect, this University's service to the nation is tremendous.

Department of Chemical Engineering

The Department of Chemical Engineering, a DST-FIST sponsored department, was started in the year 1945. It was the second college to offer an undergraduate programme in Chemical Engineering in Tamilnadu. Total outlay of the funding attracted by the department from various funding agencies is 341.51 Lakhs. All the laboratories are well equipped with most modern equipment. The department offers consultancies to various leading industries. The first PhD of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology is from this department and has thus far produced 106 Ph.Ds. The department offers 12 programmes through Distance Education. It has an excellent industrial tie up. The department boasts an unparalleled support from its Alumni.

ESET - 2019

A country's growth is primarily dependent on the quality of education and the curriculum adopted in the courses. A teacher's role is important in moulding students to become employable after graduation. A statistics shows that the percentage of employable graduates is in down trend in the recent past. Effective teaching - learning process is an important tool in education. This involves not only

the nature of teacher and learner but also on the way in which the content is delivered. Retaining a learner with full focus on the subject for the entire duration of the class hour has become a challenging task nowadays due to many factors like attitude, lack of interest, increased level of distractions, etc. among the present generation. For handling such issues, teachers need additional skill sets in communication (speaking, listening, writing, presenting and documentation), time management, team management and stress management. The workshop on "Enhancing Skills for Effective Teaching - ESET" aims to enhance such skills for the teachers and to aid in making the present generation students ready for employment after graduation. The course includes lectures and practical/activity sessions on Modern tools for imparting knowledge. Illustrative methods, Dr. Phil's Test, Time and stress Management, etc.

Eligibility to apply

Teaching faculties from Colleges of Engineering, Arts, Science, Fine arts, Education, Medicine, Health Sciences, Agriculture, Polytechnics are eligible to apply.

Registration

A registration fee of Rs. 500/- has to be paid as a Demand Draft in favor of The Registrar, Annamalai University payable at Annamalainagar / Chidambaram. The Demand draft along with the duly filled in registration form should be sent by post to reach the organizers by 31 October 2019. The registration fee includes welcome kit and lunch. There is no registration fee for Annamalai University faculties (both on campus and deputed). A soft copy of the filled in registration form shall be submitted through email to the ID mentioned in the address for correspondence.
