Winners were being selected on the basis of their presentation, English vocabulary and science knowledge.


POSTER MAKING – FINAL YEAR







ESSAY WRITING – THIRD YEAR

An Essay writing competition was conducted was conducted on 30.09.2021 for pre-final year students. The topic was "Brain Chip".




POSTER MAKING – THIRD YEAR
