**CIRCULAR**

- Sub: Certain Partial Modification of Implementation of Bank Salary Account Package for University Employees -reg.

In continuation of the reference No.4 cited, as per the directions of the Government vide ref (1,2 &3) cited, Government of Tamil Nadu has entered into Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with empanelled banks namely **State Bank of India, Indian Overseas Bank, Indian Bank, Canara Bank, Axis Bank, Bank of Baroda, Union Bank of India, Punjab National Bank, Tamil Nadu State Apex Co-operative Bank (TNSC) and Bank of India** to provide enhanced salary accounts packages and welfare benefits to all Government servants including University employees working in all Faculties and Medical, Dental, Nursing, Medical Hostel.

Key benefits extended under the MoU are as follows;

1. **Personal Accident Insurance** : Coverage of upto Rs.1 Crore in the event of accidental death or permanent disability for Government servant
2. **Marriage Assistance**: Financial Assistance of Rs.5 Lakh each, upto a total of Rs.10 Lakh, will be given by the Banks for marriage expenses of daughters of the Government servant deceased due to accident, who have attained eligible age for marriage.
3. **Educational Assistance**: Higher Education Assistance of Rs.10 Lakh will be given by the banks to the daughters of the Government servant deceased due to accident, who has completed School and is pursuing higher studies.
4. **Life Insurance**: Term Life Insurance cover of Rs.10 Lakh will be given by the bank to deceased Government servant due to natural death during service period.
5. **Reduced Loan Rates**: Lower interest rate and concession on personal, housing and educational loans.

Further, in the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, the Government has also entered into MOU with **Central Bank of India**. The Employees may avail themselves of these benefits as detailed in Annexure-I of G.O.(ms) No. 53, Finance (Treasuries and Accounts-III Department, dated 26.02.2026.

Those who are willing to avail above concessions with the previously noted banks and **Central Bank of India**, it is instructed to provide salary package account number from empanelled banks to **"E" Section, Administrative Office along with copy of Bank Pass Book front page and requisition letter.**
